### **CAMP RULES:**

- 1. No PDA (Public Displays of Affection) or being in the opposite sexes living areas.
- 2. Under no circumstances should students or leaders be anywhere other than where they are scheduled to be (service, campgrounds, activity locations). It is crucial for the staff to know where groups are at all times.
- 3. No pranks. Pranks might be fun, but they can be a huge distraction. No water guns, toilet paper, shaving cream, or other prank materials.
- 4. We are asking all students, male and female, to dress modestly. For example, no short shorts, no speedos, no bikinis, shirt on at all times when not in the water, and no two-piece swimsuits.
- 5. Beach/water rules will be enforced strictly. Students should never go passed the assigned lifeguard.
- 6. If any damage is caused by a student, then they will be directly billed.
- 7. Students should be always in groups of 3 or more.
- 8. Respect all leaders, pastors, and adults. For your safety do what they ask you to do the first time..
- \*\*Campers can be sent home at parents' expense for reasons our staff seems necessary.

### **Cell Phone Policy:**

- To limit distractions cell phones will not be allowed during camp. Students will be allowed to have phones on bus trip to and from camp but not during the week.
- You can always reach your student by calling any of our Youth Staff team members listed.
