We are getting very excited about Oneighty High School Camp a.k.a. Beach Week 2026. Our staff team is working hard to make this year's camp the best week ever. It's going to be an awesome time at the beach with friends, some amazing worship, a dynamic speaker, and incredible recreation time. When are we leaving and coming back?

Check-in begins Sunday, July 5th at 8:00 pm from the Atrium. **Cross-Tower entrance** (downtown campus). We will be returning Friday, June 10th, around 11pm to the Atrium.

We will have a parent text thread through TouchPoint (registration) to communicate all updates as well as a parent Facebook group

What is the cost and what does it cover?

The cost of the trip is \$599 early bird. That's \$100 cheaper than last year! There is a \$200 deposit due at signup. **Final payment due July 1st.** Cost includes all travel, lodging, meals, t-shirt, rec, speaker, band, etc. The only thing not covered will be three travel meals to/from Florida plus additional money for souvenirs or personal spending (parent discretion).

What are the rooms like?

We will be staying in hotel-style rooms. Each room has 2 queen beds, and there will be an extra cot in each room for our leaders. Each room has a mini fridge and microwave.

We work hard to put students in rooms with their friends and small groups with their friends.. **During the majority of camp, students spend time with their roommates, small group, and their friends.** However, for our afternoon Rec time, we divide students into teams, which allows them to interact with other students in our group. They compete together during Rec for one hour each day and on Monday Night's Team Night.

What to bring:

- Bible and pen
- Watch (without phone so they know time!)
- **TOWELS!** Make sure you have plenty of towels as towels are not provided.
- Casual clothing for 5 days
- Free time beach attire for 4 days
- Swimsuits (For girls: one piece or a tankini that covers the midriff)
- Toiletries (Toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo, **sunscreen**, etc.)
- **Spending money for 4 fast food meals during travel and any souvenirs and snacks.**
- Medications (must be checked in with camp staff)
- Camp T-shirt (wear on last) day
- Rec Team Colors
- THEME NIGHT CLOTHES (TBA)

What not to bring:

- Short shorts
- No halter tops, or tube tops
- Clothes with questionable or inappropriate slogans.
- Fireworks, Alcohol, Tobacco, Drugs, or Weapons (Vapes)!
- Nothing for pranks: shaving cream, water balloons, etc.
- Electronics are allowed ONLY on the bus ride to and from camp.

CAMP RULES:

1. Campers will be sent home at the FBCWF staff's discretion for the following:
 - Bringing and/or using illegal drugs, alcohol products, tobacco products (including vapes of any kind), or weapons (including but not limited to a gun, knife, or fireworks)
 - Proof of stealing personal possessions or items belonging to the camp.
 - Being in the room of the opposite sex or any hotel guest not with us.
 - Leaving the hotel without adult supervision. Please observe "rule of 3" at travel stops and during free time at camp
 - Fighting at hotel or on the bus
 - Putting any campers in danger due to the lack of following rules and maintaining a safe camp experience
2. No P.D.A (Public Display of Affection) with anyone
3. All activities are required for you to participate in unless excused by a camp sponsor or camp nurse
4. No pranking of any kind will be permitted while at camp
5. No cell phones or smart devices (smart watches) will be allowed while at camp, but will be permitted on the bus ride to and from camp
6. No switching rooms unless approved by High School Pastor
7. Do not hang out with other Hotel Guests not associated with Oneighty. Make sure any interaction is brief and respectful. (Share Jesus and be helpful in interactions).
8. It is a FELONY to throw anything off a balcony in Panama City Beach. Please be advised.
9. Swimsuits and swim trunks are to be worn only in the swimming areas. You must wear a cover-up to and from swimming areas (no bikinis or speedos or mid-drift)
10. ****Damage to property will be billed to the families of responsible parties**
11. All medicine will be given to and administered by the camp nurse
12. You must respect and obey all adult leaders, including your small group leader and Boardwalk Hotel Staff
13. Respect all hotel guests. Any issue between you and other hotel guests will be cause to be sent home.
*The parent/guardian will be contacted by Steven or Sam for behavior worthy of being sent home
*Campers will be sent home at campers/guardian expense if any of these rules are broken. ****Campers can be sent home at parents' expense for reasons our staff seems necessary.**

Cell Phone Policy:

- To limit distractions **cell phones will not be allowed during camp**. Students WILL be allowed to have phones on bus trip to and from camp but not during the week. Phones will be taken up and stored safely for the duration of camp.
- You can always reach your student by calling any of our Youth Staff team members listed.
- Other electronics, such as an Apple Watch, AirPods, or iPad, can be brought at the student's own risk but will be taken up from bus with phones. Oneighty will not assume any responsibility for the loss or damage of a student's personal electronics during trip to and from camp.

*A student may be sent home for a violation of bringing any of the above "not to bring" items, a continual disruption of any of the Small Group times or Worship Services, or a repeated
